# *THE DAY OF RESTORATION OF THE PRIMORSKA REGION TO THE MOTHERLAND*

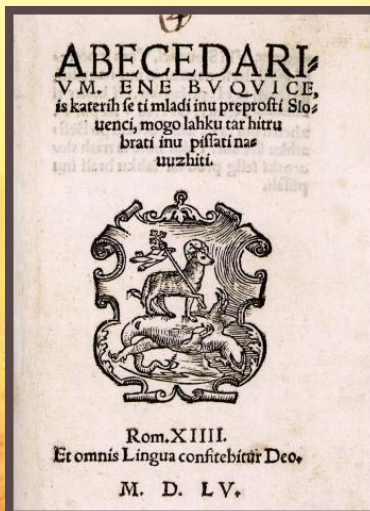
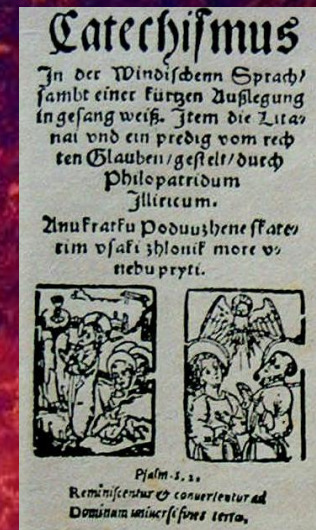
- 15<sup>th</sup> September
- It's not a non-working day
- An important day for the Primorska region  
(celebration of the day when the Primorska region  
became a part of Slovenia in 1947 with the  
implementation of Paris Peace Treaty )
- Official celebrations take place





# REFORMATION DAY

- 31<sup>st</sup> October
- Non-working day (trips, sleep all morning...)
- Celebration of Protestant Reformation
- Slovenian priest and author Primož Trubar wrote the 1<sup>st</sup> two Slovenian books in 1550 and set the foundations of Slovenian language, Slovenians began to become aware of our nation ...

# DAY (OF REMEMBERANCE) OF THE DEAD

## ALL SAINTS' DAY

- 1<sup>st</sup> November
- A non-working day
- People visit graveyards, bring flowers and light candles, families get together





# RUDOLF MAISTER DAY

- 23<sup>rd</sup> November
- It's not a non-working day
- It's an important day for the city of Maribor and the region around it
- Rudolf Maister was a military commander who disarmed German security guard in 1918 and protected an important part of Slovenian land
