

THE DAY OF RESTORATION OF THE PRIMORSKA REGION TO THE MOTHERLAND

- 15th September
- It's not a non-working day
- An important day for the Primorska region (celebration of the day when the Primorska region became a part of Slovenia in 1947 with the implementation of Paris Peace Treaty)
- Official celebrations take place



REFORMATION DAY

- 31st October
- Non-working day (trips, sleep all morning...)
- Celebration of Protestant Reformation
- Slovenian priest and author Primož Trubar wrote the 1st two Slovenian books in 1550 and set the foundations of Slovenian language, Slovenians began to become aware of our nation ...
- Official celebrations



DAY (OF REMEMBERANCE) OF THE DEAD

OR

ALL SAINTS' DAY

- 1st November
- A non-working day
- People visit graveyards, bring flowers and light candles, families get together



RUDOLF MAISTER DAY

- ❖ 23rd November
- ❖ It's not a non-working day
- ❖ It's an important day for the city of Maribor and the region around it
- ❖ Rudolf Maister was a military commander who disarmed German security guard in 1918 and protected an important part of Slovenian land
