- People visit their family and friends




## Dishes:

- In 1941 the Liberation Front was established in Ljubljana. It was the main resistance organisation during the World War II.
- Celebrations take place all over Slovenia



# INTERNATIONAL WORKING DAY

- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> May
- Non-working days since 1946
- People celebrate working rights
- People meet on tops of hills and burn bonfires
- Some wear red carnations
- Country celebrations
